## **Austin Healey Winter Service by: John Jones**

### **For those who missed the club meeting;**

The weather this week is reminding us that good driving weather isn't very far off. Therefore if you haven't done your annual service you need to get on it. Here are some of the things that you should do every year. They aren't that difficult, you just need to put the car up on jack stands and start down the list. If you don't you are going to be saying "I wish I could go on the drive today but I haven't serviced the car yet".

Change engine oil & filter

Change gearbox oil every 10,000 miles. Use GL4 75-90 gear oil

Change differential oil every 20,000 miles

Grease the chassis & drive shaft. Cars before BJ8 have grease fittings on the rear springs

Look for any signs of suspension bushing wear

Check shock oil. You can use AW 68 hydraulic oil. Leave about 3/8" air space at the top.

Check all exhaust hangers

Check for loose or broken bolts & nuts

Check brake fluid level and look for any signs of leaks at; master cylinders, look under the dash at the operating end of the master cylinders, front calipers and rear wheels. Signs at the rear could be either leaking wheel cylinders or hub seal leaks.

Look at the thickness of front pads.

Adjust rear brake shoes – how to

Check coolant and hoses. Hoses should feel soft and flexible

Check fan belt, check for tightness and any signs of cracking or fraying. Belt should have about 3/8" flex

Top up carb dampers to 1/2" below the top of the PISTON top.

Check the oil level in the steering box and idler box.

Check the battery cables at the battery and at the solenoid for tightness

Check the tires and check the date codes. If over 8 years old consider replacing

Check the wheel spokes for tightness

Rotate the tires and clean the inside of the tires and wheels

Check the wiper blades

Do any piddly things that you have been meaning to do
